

Admission Requirements:

(1) Applicants should be high school graduates (B.C. Certificate of Graduation - "Dogwood Diploma" or B.C. Adult Graduation Diploma - "Adult Dogwood") OR 19 years or older at the start of the applicant's program.

(2) Applicants who wish to qualify as domestic students must produce valid documentation confirming their legal status as Canadian citizens or permanent residents.

(3) Applicants classified as International students must meet the requirements for international students studying in Canada as listed by Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC).
